

AGREEMENT OF DOUBLE DEGREE

Between

UNIVERSITY of WEST BOHEMIA

And

**ÉCOLE SUPÉRIEURE D'INGÉNIEURS EN ÉLECTRONIQUE ET
ÉLECTROTECHNIQUE**

The WEST BOHEMIA UNIVERSITY in PILSEN, located at Univerzitní 8, Plzen, Czech Republic, identification number DIČ: CZ49777513, IČ: 49777513, represented by the Rector, Associated Professor Josef Prusa, nominated by the Decree of 24.2.2004, hereafter referred to as **UWB**, and the ÉCOLE SUPÉRIEURE D'INGÉNIEURS EN ÉLECTRONIQUE ET ÉLECTROTECHNIQUE, located at 2 boulevard Blaise-Pascal, Cité Descartes, BP 99, 93162, Noisy-Le-Grand, Cedex, France, represented by the Director, Professor Dominique PERRIN, hereafter referred to as **ESIEE Paris**, agree to establish the present double degree instrument in compliance with the current legal regulations.

First Clause – Of the Object

Based on the cooperation between UWB and ESIEE Paris, these two institutions agreed to establish a common Master Study Programme in Engineering to make possible for the students of the both institutions to obtain simultaneously the Diploma of Electrical Engineer at UWB and the Diploma of Engineer at ESIEE Paris.

Second Clause – Of the student selection

The UWB will select each of its students to the study at ESIEE Paris. The ESIEE Paris will select each of its students to the study at UWB. ESIEE Paris and UWB will jointly validate the final acceptance of these students for the Double Degree programme.

Third Clause – Studies organization of the UWB students

The UWB students that have achieved the Bachelor Study Programme of the Electrical Engineering at the UWB will accomplish the following activities.

- *1st Year*

To pass at ESIEE Paris all the modules of the ESIEE Paris fourth year programme with an amount of sixty ECTS credits in accordance with the ESIEE Paris academic rules.

- *2nd year*

To pass at UWB the modules of the second year of the Master programme at one or more of the following departments: Department of Applied Electronics and Telecommunications, Department of Technologies and Measurement, Department of Electro-mechanics and Power Electronics with an amount of sixty ECTS credits in accordance with the UWB academic rules.

- *3rd year-1st semester*

To pass at ESIEE Paris all the modules of the first semester of the fifth year programme with an amount of thirty ECTS credits

To pass the proficiency language tests in English and in French in accordance with the ESIEE Paris academic rules

- *3rd year-2nd semester*

To work out the Final Project (FP) at UWB or ESIEE-Paris or industry advised by a professor from ESIEE-Paris and by a professor from UWB with an amount of thirty ECTS credits. The FP has to be defended at ESIEE-Paris or UWB. The FP report is written in English, with the Czech abstract. At its completion, the students defend their FP at ESIEE-Paris or UWB in front of a jury made of representatives of both institutions, if necessary through videoconference.

To pass state examinations in accordance with the Faculty of Electrical Engineering UWB academic rules. All subjects passed at UWB are already accredited by the Czech Ministry of Education.

Fourth Clause – Studies organization of the ESIEE-Paris students

The ESIEE Paris students that have finished the Study Programme of the third year ESIEE Engineering Programme will accomplish the following activities:

- *1st Year*

To pass at UWB the modules of the master at one or more of the following departments: Applied Electronics and Telecommunications, Department of Technologies and Measurement, Department of Electromechanics and Power Electronics with an amount of 60 ECTS credits in accordance with the UWB academic rules.

- *2nd Year-1st semester*

To pass at ESIEE Paris all the modules of the fifth year first semester programme with an amount of thirty ECTS credits in accordance with the ESIEE Paris academic rules.

To pass the proficiency language tests in English in accordance with the ESIEE Paris academic rules.

- 2nd year-2nd semester

To work out the Final Project (FP) at UWB or ESIEE-Paris or industry advised by a professor from ESIEE Paris and by a professor from UWB with an amount of thirty ECTS credits. The FP has to be defended at ESIEE Paris or UWB. The FP report is written in English, with the French abstract. At its completion, the students defend their FP at ESIEE-Paris or UWB in front of a jury made of representatives of both institutions, if necessary through videoconference.

To pass the State Examinations in accordance with the Faculty of Electrical Engineering UWB academic rules.

Fifth Clause – Of the students advising

The host institution must design for exchange students an advisor professor, which will be an interlocutor between UWB and ESIEE Paris during the all stay of the student in the institution.

Sixth Clause – Of the diploma issue

Both institutions, UWB and ESIEE Paris, will issue both diplomas simultaneously to the students who participated with success of the Double Degree Programme.

Seventh Clause – Of the enrollment and academic taxes

Every year, at maximum 2 (two) students selected for participating in this programme pay the enrollment and annual fees in their origin institute and they are exempt to pay enrollment and academic taxes at the host institutions.

By mutual agreement other students can be admitted in the Double Degree Programme. They will have to pay all fees and taxes at the both institutions.

Eighth Clause – Of the health insurance and student visa

The students that participate in the Double Degree Programme must have a plain health insurance cover during their stay in the host country. Students from third non European Union countries will need the visa.

Ninth Clause – Of the Rights and Rules

The students that participate in the Double Degree Programme must attend the academic rules and requirements of the host institution. They will be benefited themselves for all the services that the host institution offers to all local students.

Tenth Clause – Of the Administrative Coordination

At UWB, the executive and administrative coordination of the undergraduate student exchange will be the responsibility of the Department of International Relations. At ESIEE Paris, the coordination will be the responsibility of the Department of International Relations.

Eleventh Clause – Of the validity and extension

This legal instrument will become effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of its signature by both parties. It is necessary to sign a specific legal instrument between the parties to extend the validation period.

Twelfth Clause – Of the alterations

The present legal instrument may be changed, except for its object, by means of an additional specific legal instrument agreed upon by the parties.

Thirteenth Clause – Of the denouncement / rescission

This legal instrument may be denounced by any one of the parties, at any time, by prior communication of, at least, 90 days, or may be cancelled for the failure to fulfill any of its clauses or conditions. Anticipated denouncement/cancellation of this Agreement will not interrupt the activities in progress.

Fourteenth Clause – Of the Forum

An arbitration committee made up of signatories or others appointed by them will be responsible for settling eventual disputes related to the interpretation and the execution of this document.

The presented legal instrument is signed in two bilingual copies, Czech and English, of equal form and content.
